Wireless Printing

Don't forget that you can now send a print job directly from your laptop, phone, or tablet while in the library or even from home via the Wireless Printing button found at the top right of our website. You can upload your files and then come to the library to pay for them and pick them up from the Computer Lab.

Jobs are held for 24 hours and you'll pay when you come to get them. Prints cost 25¢ per side for letter (8 ½" by 11") and legal (8 ½" by 14") sizes and you can pay with cash or a credit card for both color and black and white. After attaching your file, you will put in your user info and then hit the submit button. To print from a website email tbs-MAPLD-bw@eprintitservice.com for B&W Submissions and tbs-MAPLDcoloreprintitservice.com for Color Submissions. After that you will come to the Library's Public Services department, go to the kiosk at the Computer Lab desk, and put in your user information to pay for your prints.

Project Next Generation

Once again the library is a proud recipient of the Project Next Generation grant. This grant enables us to offer mentoring and S.T.E.A.M. programming to those in junior high and high school.

Secretary of State Jesse White awards Project Next Generation (PNG) grants to public libraries statewide. PNG is a mentoring program created by Secretary White and administered through Illinois public libraries. Using project-based learning, mentors expose students to various technologies while helping students to develop life skills such as effective communication, goal-setting, and conflict resolution.

This is the library's ninth year as a PNG recipient. Over the years, the library has received over \$300,000 in grant funds.
